Introduction:

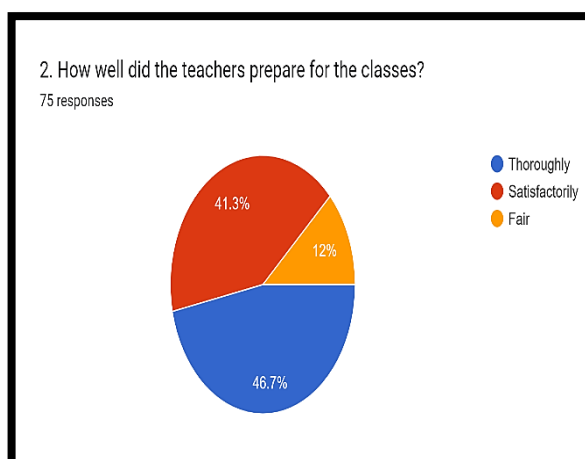
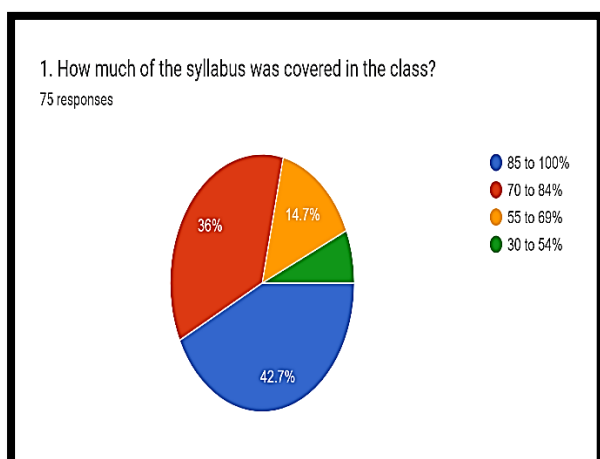

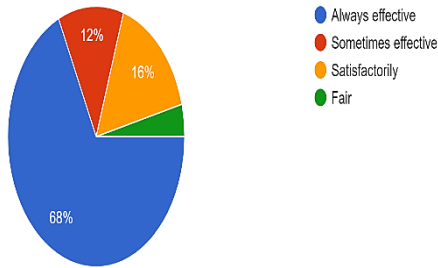
1. Teachers abilities, skills and attributes

Student satisfaction Survey on overall institutional performance was taken from the B.Ed. and M.Ed. students for the year 2022-23. Student responses were presented in graphical format:



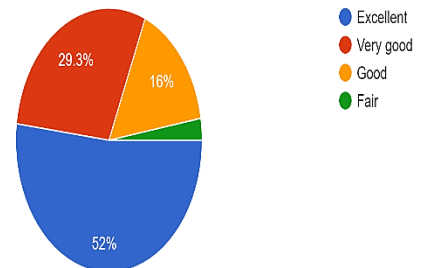

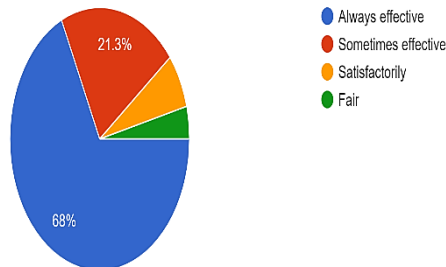
4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as

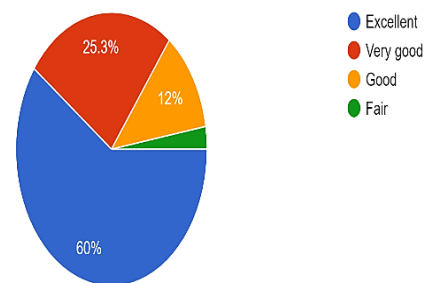
5. Use of ICT by the Teachers for teaching

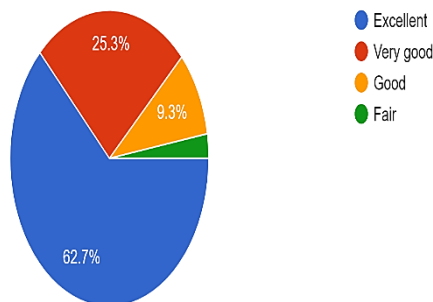
6. Planning of the microteaching and practice teaching by the college

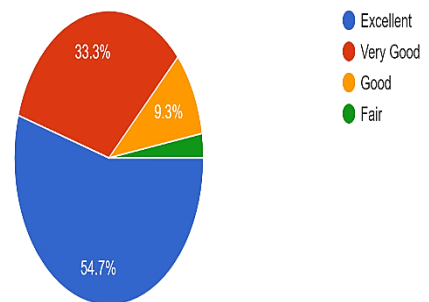
7. Ability of the Teacher educators for guidance

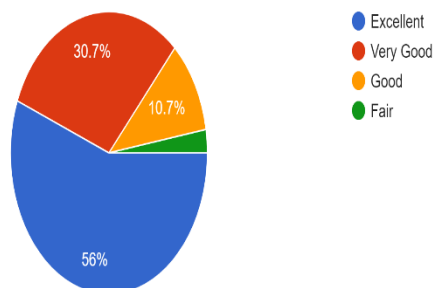
8. Environment in the college for microteaching and practice teaching

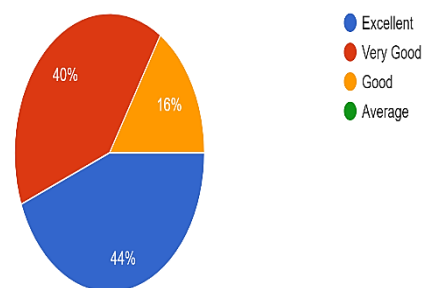
9. Evaluation of the microteaching and practice teaching

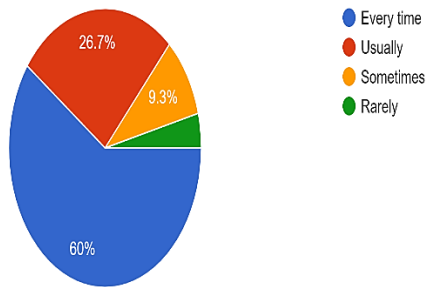
10. Internal evaluation process by the teachers.

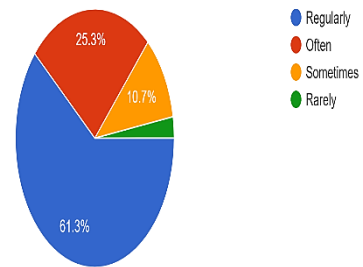
11. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?

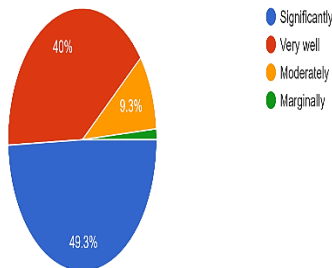
12. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.

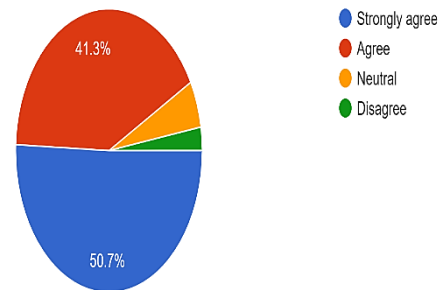
13. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.

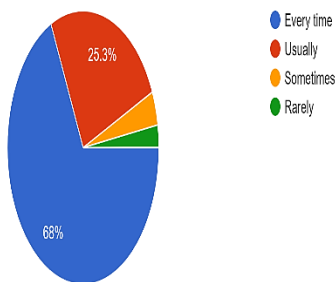
14. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.

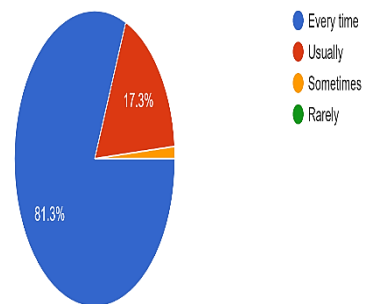
15. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes & programme outcomes.

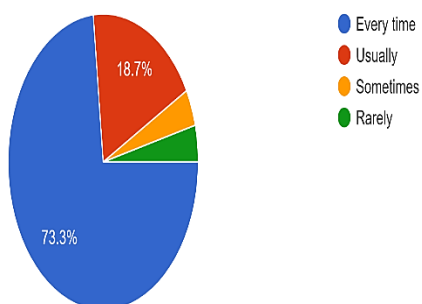
16. Your Group Incharge (mentor) does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.

Major Observations and action taken:

1. It was noticed that, the majority of students have responded that 85 to 100% syllabus was covered in the class. There is a scope for the teachers to make efforts for completion of the syllabus.

Action Taken:

At the end of the academic year the institute extra lectures conducted by the faculty for the revision and doubt clearance regarding the syllabus content.

2. Majority of the students were happy with the academic environment of the college.

Action Taken:

The Institution encourages the holistic development of our students through diverse teaching pedagogies. Additionally, a well-stocked library with extensive reading space has been made available to the students for accessing primary and secondary study material. Moreover, Tilak College of Education ensures the inculcation of extra-academic skills by offering a wide array of extracurriculars and activities to the students.

3. 68% of respondents rated the contribution of the ICT (Information and Communications Technology) facilities in Tilak College of Education in creating a technologically upgraded pedagogical environment.

Action Taken:

The institution has taken cognizance of this parameter and these concerns have been shared with the relevant authority for consideration and necessary action to strengthen the ICT infrastructure is already on. Wi-fi connection with good connectivity speed is made available in the institute. Institute is having plans for adopting Software of Learning Management System (LMS). Training for the implementation of LMS will be given to faculty members and teachers.

4. Observation on Open Ended Responses:

- Majority of students demanded more books in the library regarding syllabus and competitive exams. Students want more space in the library.
- Students demanded more digital study material from teachers.

Action Taken:

Institute has separate provisions in the budget for book purchase. In 2022-23 budget books and journals have been purchased as per the demand of students and faculty. Institute is working on developing digital study material for the use of teaching learning of the course content.
