After the presentation of the students, the keynote speaker Dr. Mugdha Gadgil had an open dialogue session on the topic of "The Feminine aspect of the Sun". She

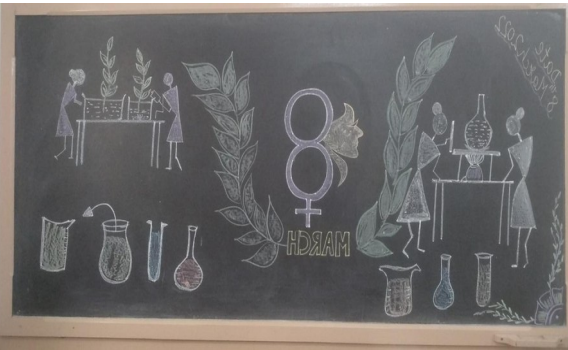

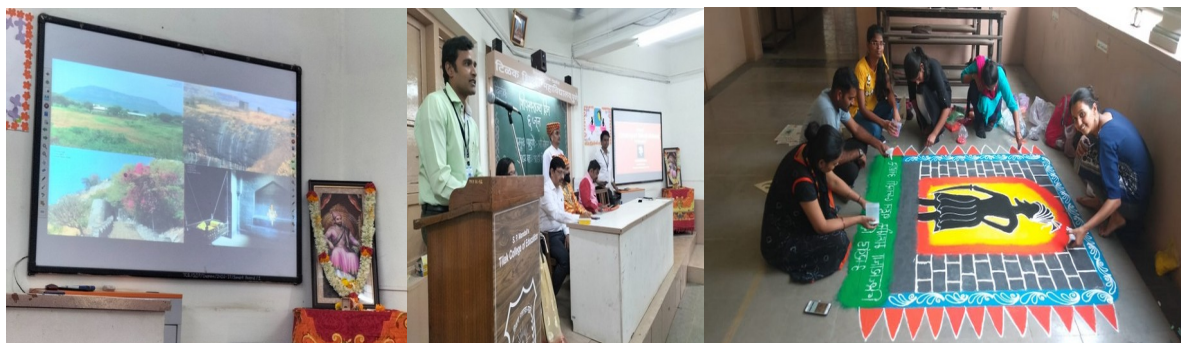




Shivswaraj din

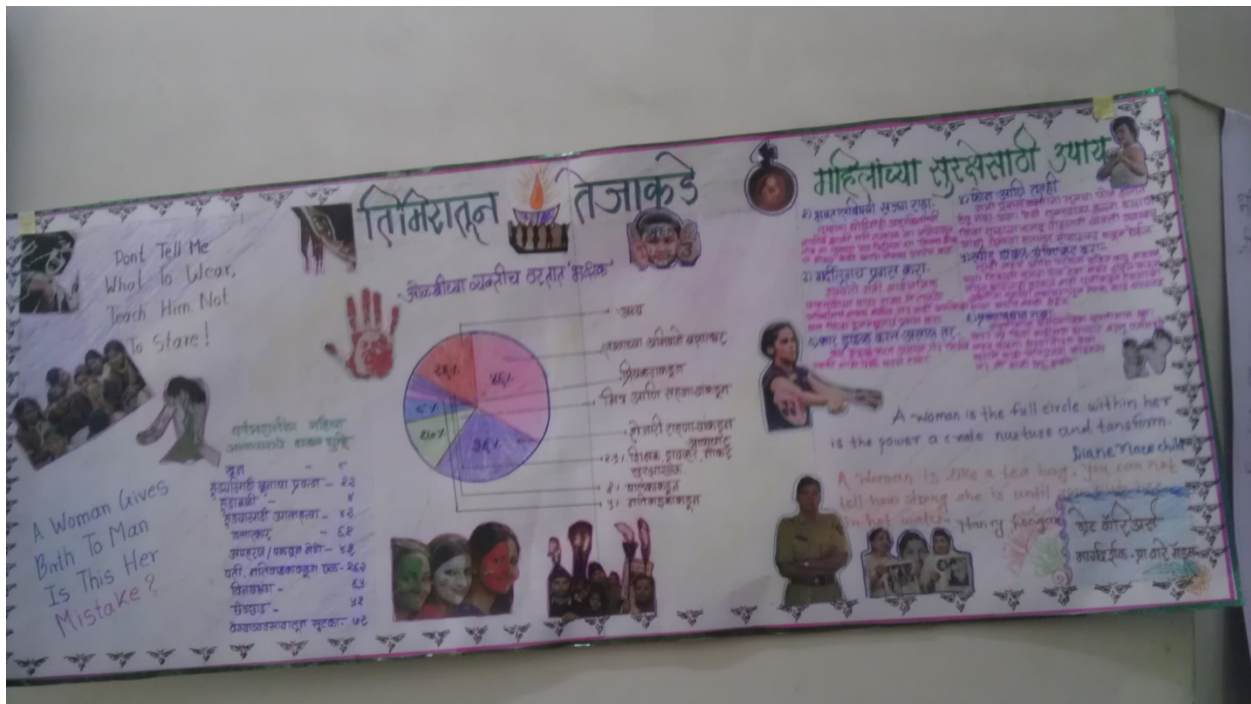
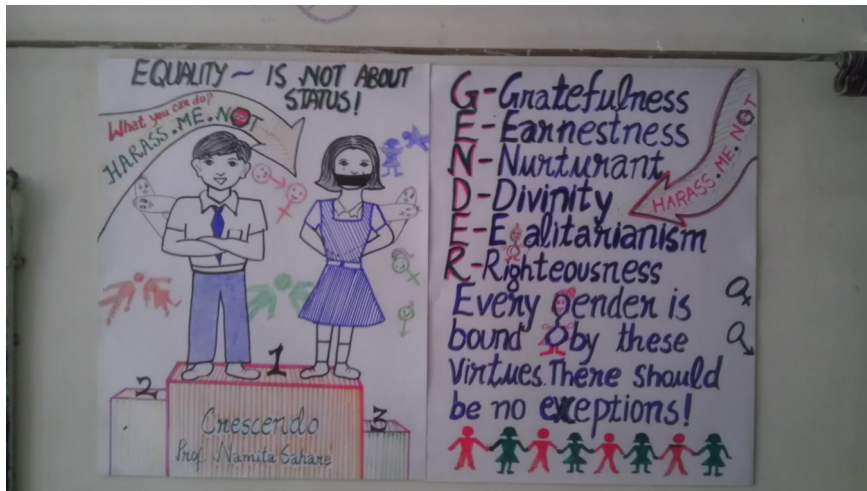
The college appreciated and felicitated them with flower bouquets and book for their achievements in B.Ed. Principal Dr. Radhika Inamdar in her orientation

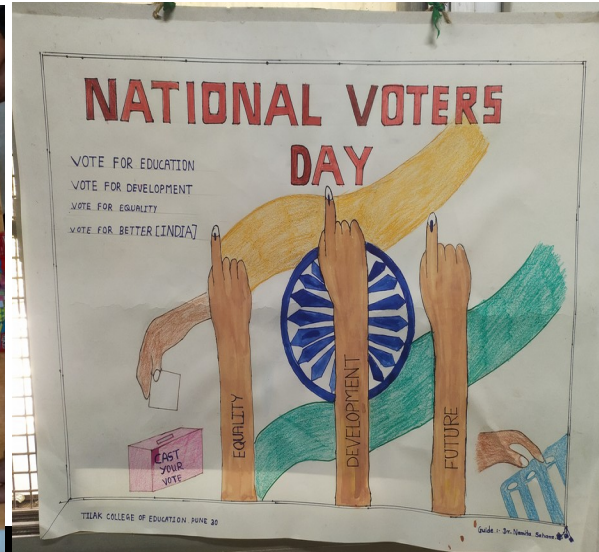
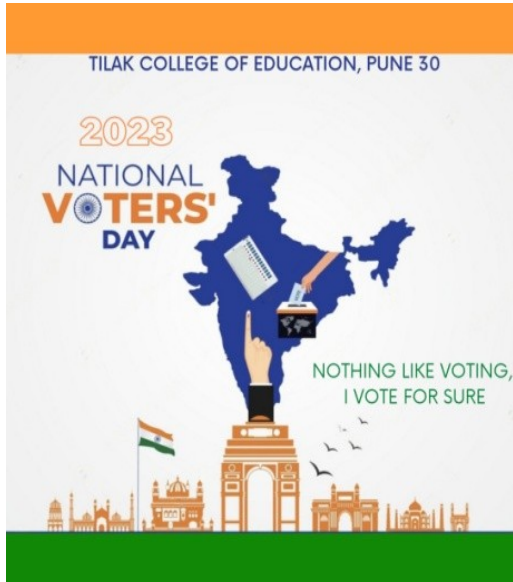
Makar Sankranti Videos: The celebration continued with the screening of videos showcasing the exuberant celebrations of Makar Sankranti across different

Sahare with cooperation of all the staff. Such Programme are a source to increase knowledge and awareness among the citizens.

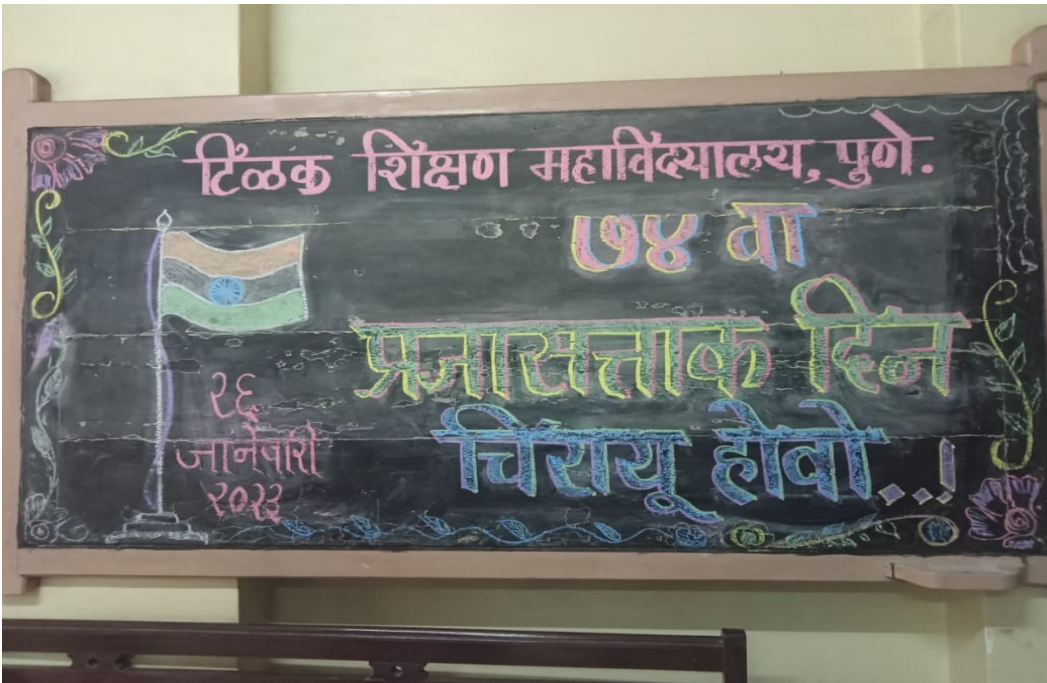




Republic Day 2023
