MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (the "MoU") is made at Pune on the Twentieth day of the month of August 2024.

BETWEEN

The Reflection Foundation, Pune is a Non-Government Trust established with registration No. MAH/534/2011, F-28958 through its authorized Signatory Mrs. Anagha Rajendra Dorle President, Reflection Foundation, Plot No. 6 building No. 4, Gauri Shankar Park Housing Society, Benkar Vasti, Dhayri, Pune 411041 which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, mean and include its successors, legal representatives and permitted assigns of the FIRST PART;

AND

Tilak College of Education, Pune, Maharashtra, India, an aided College established

on 20th June 1941 by Shikshan Prasarak Mandali, Pune, and at present permanently affiliated with Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune imparting Teacher Education. Tilak College of Education is included as an affiliated college by the University Grants Commission (UGC) New Delhi under Section 2(f) and Section 12 (B) of UGC Act, 1956, hereinafter referred to as the "Tilak College of Education", through its authorized Dr. Radhika Inamdar, Principal, Tilak College of Education, S. P. College campus, Pune-411030, India, which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, mean and include its successors, legal representatives and permitted assigns of the **SECOND PART**.

Each of Reflection Foundation, Pune and Tilak College of Education shall be individually referred to as the "**Party**" and collectively as the "**Parties**"

WHEREAS the Reflection Foundation, having a vision to develop, build and implement various activities for sensitizing the community and train its members regarding social issues. The motive of Reflection Foundation is to create awareness and train the manpower in the fields of Education, Mental Health, Counselling Agriculture, Animal Husbandry, Dairying & Fisheries, Art & Culture, Biotechnology, Children, Civic Issues, Differently Aabled, Disaster Management, Education and Literacy, Aged/Elderly, Environment and Forests, Health and Family Welfare, Human Rights, Information and Communication Technology, Legal Awareness and Aid, Micro Finance (SHGs), New and Renewable Energy, Nutrition, Panchayati Raj, Right to Information and Advocacy, Rural Development & Poverty Alleviation, Science and Technology, Scientific and Industrial Research, Sports, Tourism, Urban Development and Poverty Alleviation, Vocational Training, Water Resources, Women's Development and Empowerment and Youth Affairs in Maharashtra.

AND

WHEREAS the Tilak College of Education, Pune is a premier and dynamic institution with an unrivaled reputation in pre-service training of teachers. Lokmanya Tilak, the eminent educationist and freedom fighter was the inspiring force in the establishment of the college.

The College has been imparting quality teacher education for the past 83 years. It is affiliated to the Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune, and is located in the heart of Pune city. It is one of the premier and reputed institutions in the field of teacher training in the country. It has become an educational hub offering B. Ed, M. Ed, and Ph.D. courses. The institution is actively engaged in the pursuit of teaching, research, and extension activities. It has excellent Infrastructure facilities, well-equipped laboratories, and a resourceful library.

It prepares teachers, teacher educators, and researchers with sensitive and probing minds. It is actively engaged in the task of teaching, research, and extension.



Meticulous planning, prompt execution, and adapting to the changing needs of society are the strengths of the college in its endeavor towards the pursuit of excellence.

The educational programmes, Vision and Mission, values, goals, and objectives are in alignment with the NCTE and UGC. The College of Education was established in the year 1941, was affiliated to Mumbai University, Mumbai and then in the year 1949 it came under Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune with B.Ed. , M.Ed., M.Phil. and Ph.D. in Education.

UNDERSTANDING:

Reflection Foundation, Pune and Tilak College of Education hereby agree to collaborate as follows:

This MoU enables both the parties to collaborate with each other in organizing Training programmes, Competitions, Conferences, Seminars, symposia and Workshops to sensitize and train the students and teachers regarding social issues.

Both parties have agreed to collaborate with each other for **research projects**.

Both parties shall permit each other to show their relationship with the other institution in any of the publication or publicity material put out by the respective organization with prior permission of the other institution.

Both parties also wish to collaborate with us for the **outreach and community engagement programmes**. Reflection Foundation is already undergoing outreach activities. So both the parties will jointly conduct programmes for them and students will be exchanged from Tilak College of Education to work under these outreach programmes.

Both parties agree to actively **promote each other's programmes and activities** of mutual interest to students, faculty, other members of the institution and general community.

Both parties agree that they are not bound exclusively by this MoU and shall be at liberty to enter into any separate agreements or arrangements with any other third party (or institution) without reference to the other party.

PERIOD OF MOU

Both parties desire to have a long term and mutually rewarding relationship. However, at present both the parties agree that this MOU shall be valid for a period of **five years** from the year **2024 to 2029** with provision for further extension with mutual consent. This agreement will take effect immediately after signing by both parties. The agreement may be modified at any time by the mutual consent of both the parties and may be terminated by either party after giving six months advance notice.
