## National voters day 2023 : A Report

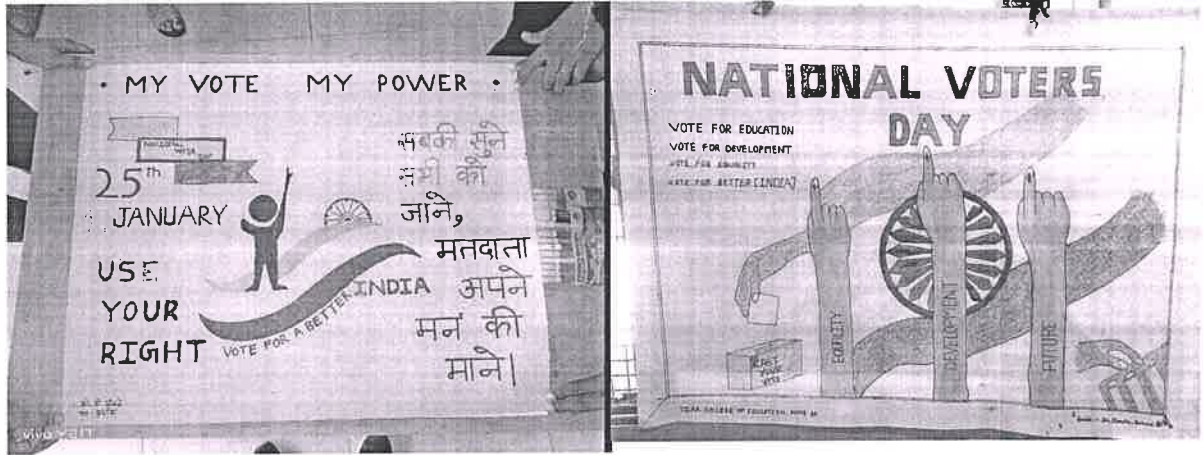

After the warm up all of us

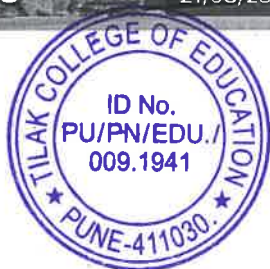
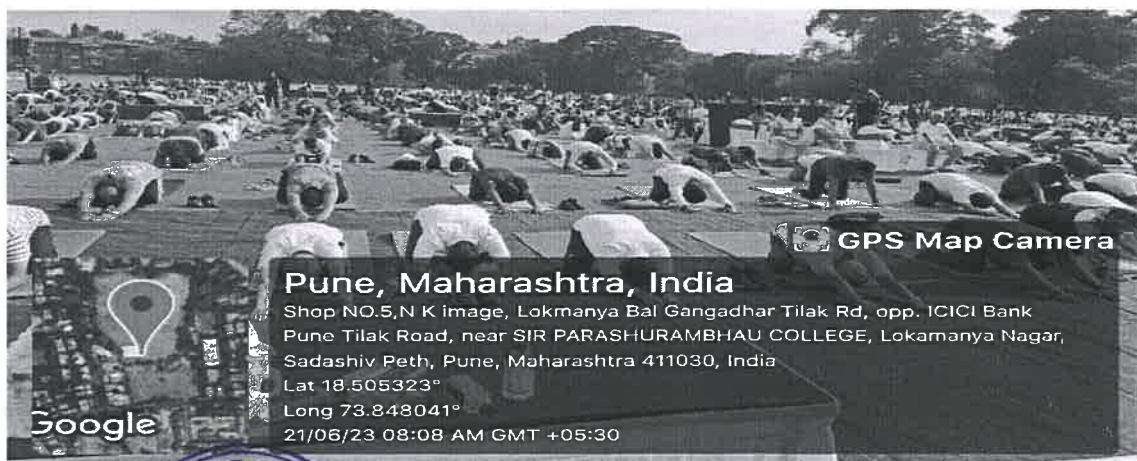
asked to perform any five asanas but Surya namaskar was compulsory for all as it is the sum of all asanas. Everybody performed various asanas filling the environment

So to fulfil the expectation from Government and aware the students about eco-friendly life style, Tilak College of Education ,Pune has arranged an Online lecture by well-known and studious person Mr.Ratnakar Phadtare dated 17 th May,11.30 at Zoom Platform.

She has shared the role of India in G20 summit and focused the role and responsibilities of education college regarding it. 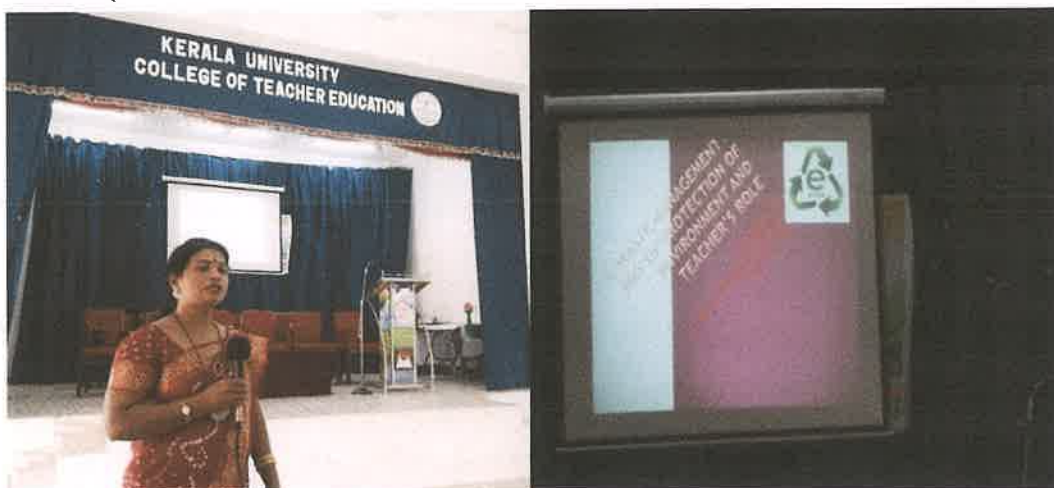
## **A Report on the Special Lecture on Environmental Protection Initiative in Swachh Bharat (Organised by IQAC)**
