
Benefits and Future Prospects:

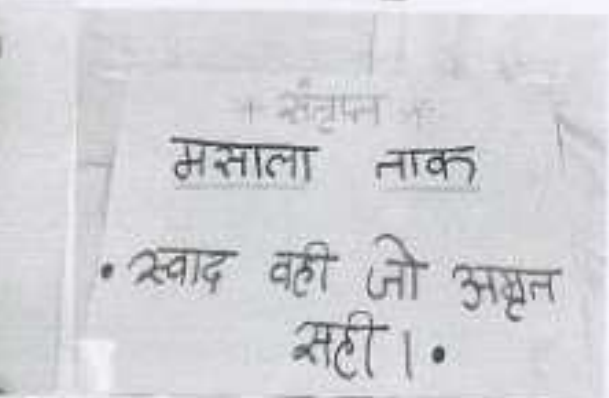

Study Tour Report: Exploring Pune Metro as a Model of Tertiary Occupation

Date of the visit - 03.03.2023 timing 3.00 to 5.00pm

Visit - Garware stop to Vanaz Stop Pune

Learning Outcomes -

- Student explains the nature of the initial procedure to get in the metro train.
- Student describes the important instructions and signs at the metro station.
- Student lists out the stops, timing, seating capacity etc. details.
- Student explains the relation of metro as a tertiary occupation with context to other types of occupations.
- Students illustrate the relation of environment and metro train project.
- Introduction:
 - The study tour conducted with a group of 30 geography students in Pune aimed to provide an in-depth understanding of the city's metro system as a prime example of tertiary occupation. Tertiary occupations involve providing services rather than producing goods, and the Pune Metro serves as a significant illustration of this concept within the urban infrastructure.

Description of the visit -

The visit was declared one week before, learning outcomes and the plan was discussed with the students. The list was prepared. After the regular lectures of the college, students left by groups and reached till 3.15pm. There were 30 students and two faculties i.e. Dr.Suresh Isave and Dr. Jotsna Kamble. The model of the metro projects was displayed. The faculty explained it. Then does and don'ts communicated. The tickets were drawn by scanning a QR code. By following the protocol, we all entered at the station. We took a tickets and had dialogue with metro officials. We took a round trip of Garware college to Vanaz Corner from 3.30 to 4.30.

Itinerary:

1. Metro Station Visit

The study tour began with a visit to one of the prominent metro stations in Pune. Students observed the station's layout, signage, and various facilities



available for commuters. This experience offered insights into the integral role of customer service and passenger convenience, both key aspects of tertiary occupations.

2. Guided Tour of Control Center:

The group was granted access to the metro's control center, where they learned about the intricate operations that facilitate smooth metro functioning. The students observed how real-time data, communication systems, and advanced technology play a crucial role in ensuring a safe and efficient travel experience for passengers.

3. Interaction with Metro Officials:

Students had the opportunity to interact with metro officials responsible for different aspects of the system, including customer service, maintenance, and safety. These discussions shed light on the various tertiary roles involved in managing and maintaining the metro system.

4. Discussion on Employment Opportunities:

A session was conducted to discuss the diverse employment opportunities generated by the metro system. From station management to ticketing, maintenance, security, and even urban planning and development, the metro has given rise to a range of tertiary occupation options for the city's workforce.

Stations house retail outlets, cafes, and other amenities, contributing to the overall passenger experience and further exemplifying tertiary occupation principles.
- **Economic Impact:** The metro's development and operation have led to economic growth and urban transformation. The influx of businesses near metro stations and increased accessibility have contributed to enhanced tertiary sector activities, such as shopping, dining, and entertainment.
- **Technological Advancements:** The study tour highlighted the significance of advanced technology in managing the metro system. From ticketing systems to automated announcements, GPS tracking, and real-time information dissemination, students witnessed firsthand how technology has revolutionized tertiary occupations in the transportation sector.

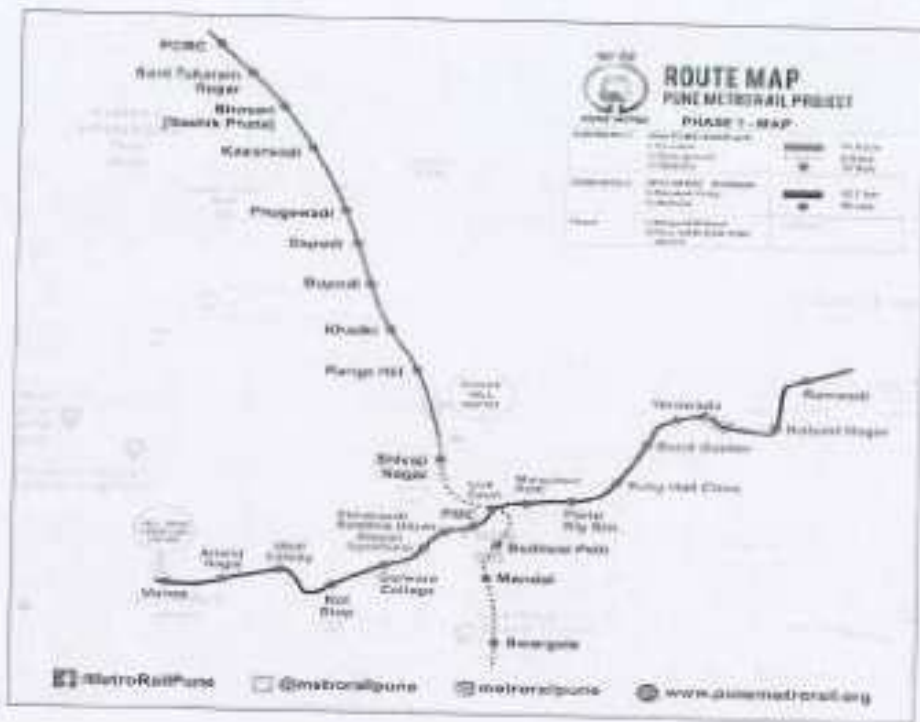


- Student-teacher describes the concept of Augmented Reality.

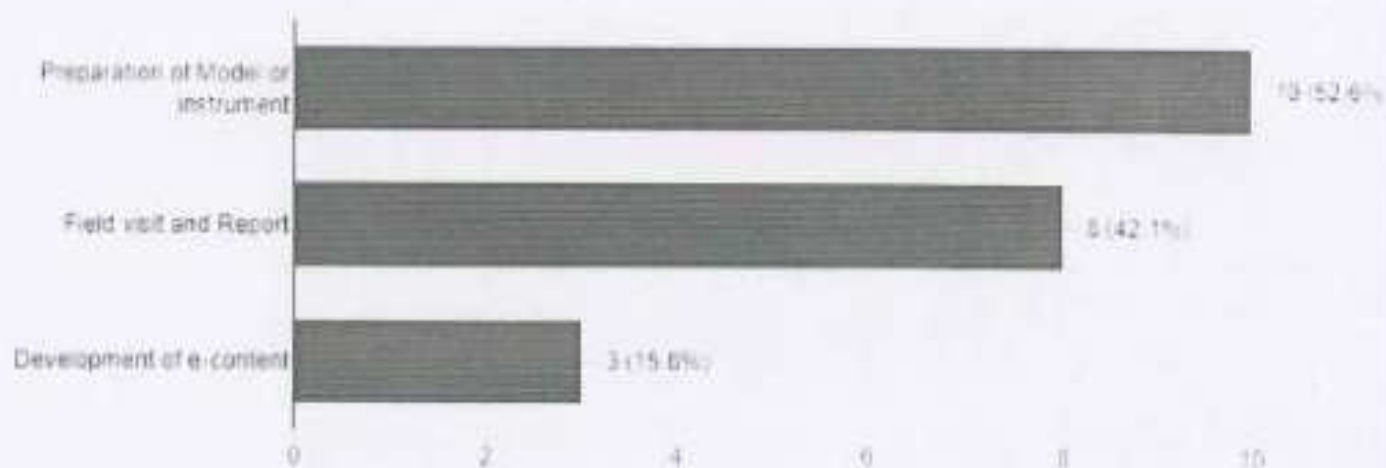

Emphasizing the significance of proper citation and avoiding plagiarism, he ensured that they not only developed their research prowess but also understood the ethical dimensions of academic writing.


Through individualized guidance and interactive sessions, he aimed to instill in them the confidence to articulate their ideas coherently and contribute meaningfully to their field of study.
