Enhanced Understanding: Participants gained a better understanding of audit procedures and TDS compliance, improving their ability to handle financial matters effectively.


Increased Confidence: Non-teaching staff members expressed increased confidence in managing financial tasks, which is crucial for the efficient operation of educational institutions.



The PFMS is an essential tool for effective financial management and transparency in government and public sector organizations. It enables the electronic transfer of funds, tracking of expenditures, and real-time monitoring of financial transactions. To harness the full potential of PFMS, it is crucial for office staff to receive proper training.

Training Objectives:

The primary objectives of the PFMS training program were as follows:

Training Outcomes:


The PFMS training program yielded the following outcomes:

Then he highlights on inclusion of content supporting Indian Tradition in curriculum.






In these discussions challenges in implementation and solutions were mainly discussed.





Dr. Rajshree Rathod expertly compared the workshop, ensuring a smooth flow of events and engaging the audience throughout the day.


Conclusion
