#### Training Outcomes:


The PFMS training program yielded the following outcomes:

#### Conclusion:



After the presentation of the papers Prof. Dr. Shingte madam gave a speech of chairperson.


She had taken a recap of all papers and done analysis of all the papers with best wishes.

Then he highlights on inclusion of content supporting Indian Tradition in curriculum.

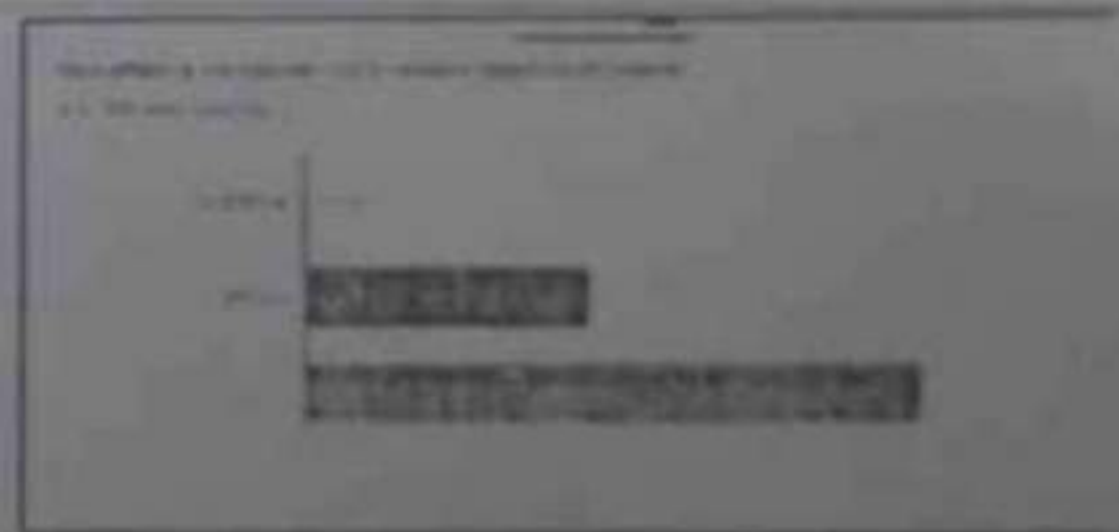
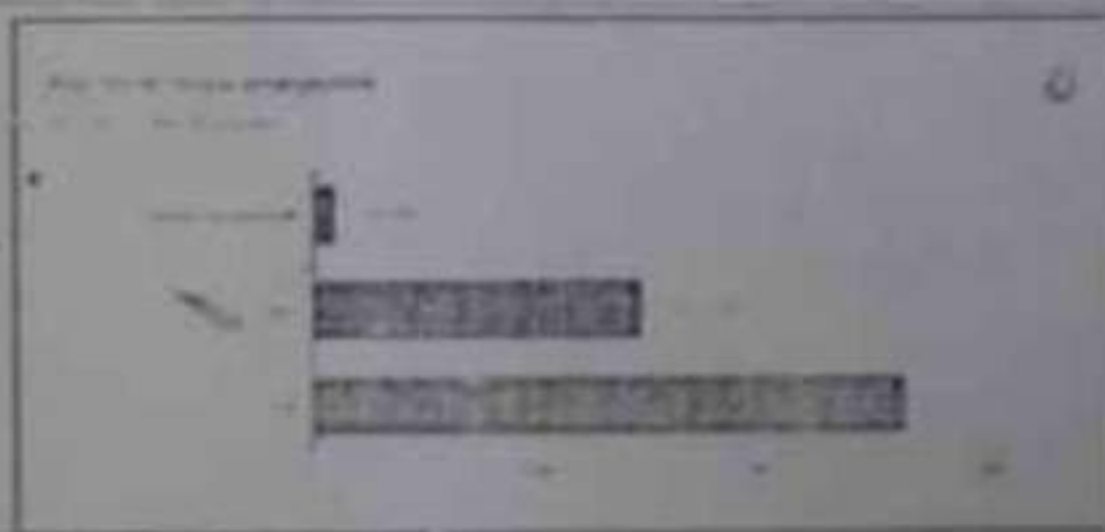
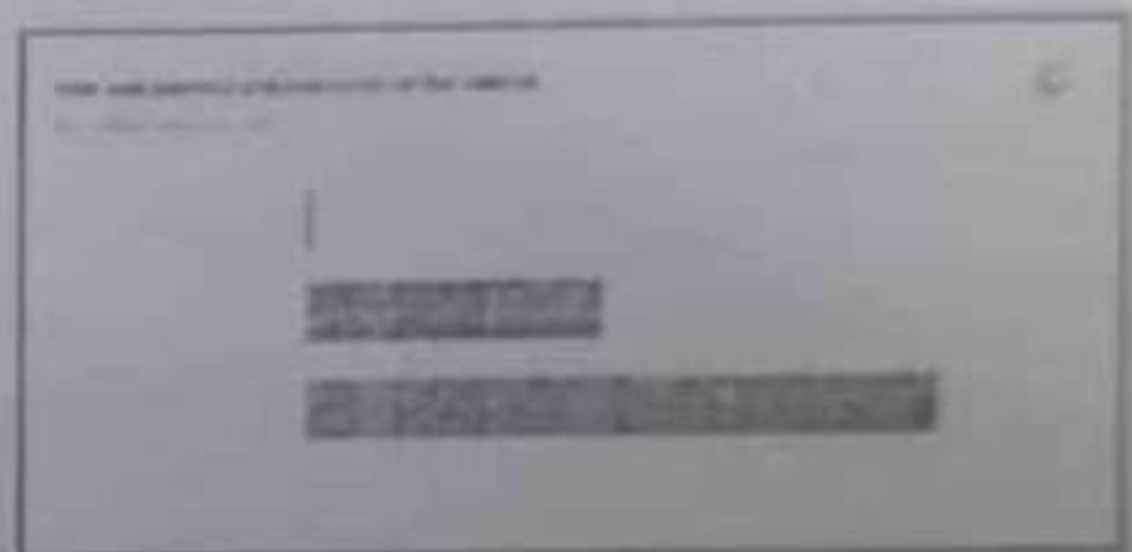
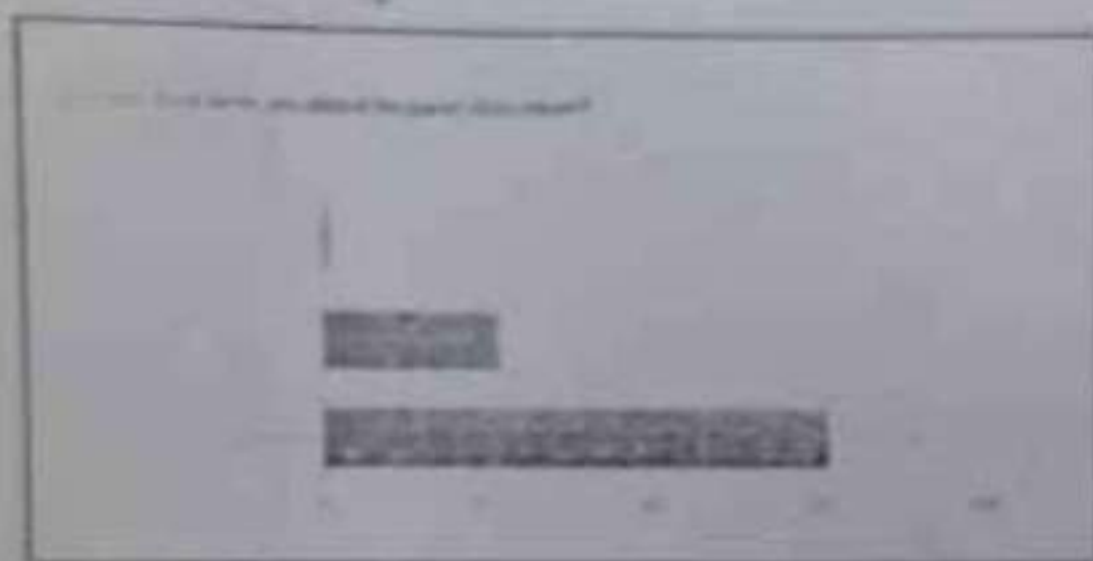

Dr. Rajshree Rathod expertly compared the workshop, ensuring a smooth flow of events and engaging the audience throughout the day.




## Conclusion
