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GENERAL DIRECTIONS

- 1. The students are requested to note that the High Schools used for practice lessons are not a part of the College but are sister institutions offering to the College their fullest co-operation. It should be the first care of the students to see that do nothing that might make this co-operation

- If they want to meet subject teachers to know more about the work done, they should see them 3. outside the class-room during the short or long recess.
- 4. For the observation of a lesson they should step into the class-room before the lesson begins.
- All lesson equipment which the schools can spare will be at the disposal of the College student who will do well to spend some time in the school libraries and be familiar with their stock of 5 books, pictures, diagram, maps etc. Demand for books, pictures, lab apparatus etc. should be submitted in writing.
- 6. Under no circumstances will the students enter into a dispute with the members of the schoolstaff. If they have any complaint grievances, redress should be sought, through the Principal.
- Previous planning and punctuality ensure success. The College students are therefore advised 7. to plan their work in advance, collect all lesson-aids on the previous day and be punctual in attendance.
- Immediately after a lesson is announced, see the College librarian and seek her help. She will 8. give you the information and material required.
- All lesson-aids, books, maps, pictures etc. taken for a lesson from the library should be returned 9 immediately after the lesson is over.
- 10. During classroom lectures & Lab activities students are not allowed to seat in the library unless it is told. Eating Food in classrooms is not allowed.
- 11. If, for only valid reason, a student is not able to take his/her lesson at the scheduled time. previous permission in writing should be obtained from the Principal. Informing Principal and Lesson Incharge about inability to conduct Lesson is mandatory.
- 12. Regarding usage of cell phone students to follow the University norms.

Constitution of India Part IV A (Article 51 A)

Fundamental Duties

Fundamental Duties - It shall be the duty of every citizen of India-

- (h) to develop the scientific temper, humanism and the spirit of inquiry and reform;
- (i) to safeguard public property and to abjure violence;
- to strive towards excellence in all spheres of individual and collective activity so that the nation constantly rise to higher levels of endeavour and achievement;
- (k) who is a parent or guardian, to provide opportunities for education to his child o as the case may be, between the age of six and fourteen years.
