Report of Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) on overall institutional performance

Year 2023-24

Introduction:

Tilak college of education is situated in Pune. It is affiliated with Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune. The college offer various courses like B.Ed., M.Ed., M.Phil. and Ph.D. in faculty of education. The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the college is has continuously been working on quality improvement and the betterment of the students learning experiences. In order to analyse the strengths and lag areas of the college and scope for further improvement, feedback from students have been received. This report focuses on the feedback of the students on overall institutional performance.

Data Collection and analysis:

An effort was made to receive feedback from all students of the college. For this purpose, a google form was created and sent to students. Total 114 responses have been received out of which 74 responses received from B.Ed. students and 41 responses received from M.Ed. students. In order to arrive to comprehensive results, useful statistical tools like percentage, etc. have been used. For the effective presentation of the data, various types of graphs have been used.

Student satisfaction Survey on overall institutional performance was taken from the B.Ed. and M.Ed. students for year 2023-24. Following parameters was considered for the survey.

1. Teachers abilities, skills and attributes
2. Usage of Innovative Teaching Methodologies
3. Learning Environment
4. Support Services
5. Internal Evaluation

Major Observations and action taken:

1. It was noticed that, majority of student i.e. 80% of the students have responded that, 70 to 100% syllabus was covered in the class. There is a scope for the teachers to make efforts for completion of the syllabus, as around 20% students were responded that 30 to 70 % syllabus is covered.

Action Taken:

2. 92% of students were happy with the academic environment of the college.

Action Taken:

The Institution encourages the holistic development of our students through diverse teaching pedagogies. Additionally, a well-stocked library with extensive reading space has been made available to the students for accessing primary and secondary study material. Moreover, Tilak College of Education ensures the inculcation of extra-academic skills by offering a wide array of extra-curriculars and activities to the students.

3. 93% students were satisfied with the regularity of classes and teachers' preparedness, while only 7% of students felt that classes did not regularly happen in college.

Action Taken: Timetables for each Department and faculty member are made well in advance of teaching sessions. All faculty and students are expected to follow their designated timetables. They are uploaded to the college what's app group for easy access and proper streamlining of academic processes in the college.

4. 78% of respondents rated the contribution of the ICT (Information and Communications Technology) facilities in Tilak College of Education in creating a technologically upgraded pedagogical environment as 'Always Effective' while 22% of respondents have found it 'Fair', 'Satisfactory', and 'Sometimes effective'

Action Taken:


The institution has taken cognizance of this parameter and these concerns have been shared with the relevant authority for consideration and necessary action to strengthen the ICT infrastructure is already on.
