B.Ed.

Started in the year 1941, this institution is affiliated with Savitribai Phule Pune University in Pune and offers a two-year B.Ed program. It boasts a dedicated and well-designed facility with independent buildings for various purposes, including well-equipped Psychology and Science Lab, a Computer Lab, a separate building for the Library and Reading Hall, a Multi-purpose Hall, and even sports facilities on the grounds. Post Graduate Department. Since last 40 years, M.Ed. Courses are conducted in the college on no grant basis. Up to 2006, the course was of two years duration and conducted in vacations only. From 2005-2006 the regular M.Ed. Course was established by University of Pune. This course is a full time and of one year duration. This college started its first regular batch on non-grant basis from 2009-2010.



Library Construction Information

The library building was constructed in 1979. The total area of the library is 4400 square feet, which includes a separate reading hall spanning 1800 square feet and a stacking area covering 2000 square feet

Library Operation Details

- The regular operating hours of the library are typically from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- During examination periods, the library extends its hours, opening from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. It also remains open on Sundays and holidays if require and any changes to these timings are communicated as needed.
- The library offers book lending services for home reading to all students, faculty members, and other college staff.
- A book bank facility is available, subject to a deposit payment.
- At the start of the academic year, every student is provided with a set of school textbooks (to be returned) along with essential supplies like a roll-up and duster.
- The library provides teaching aids such as maps, charts, outlines, globes, and geometry instruments.
- The Reference and Periodical Section of the library is open for open access, and it can be accessed by general sections upon request.
- The library arranges book shows to help users become familiar with its collection. Internet facilities are also available for library users.

Regular Members encompass college students, teaching faculty, visiting instructors, and support staff, as well as former staff members who are exempt from library fees.

On the other hand, Other Members include former students and external research scholars pursuing M.Phil. or Ph.D. They are granted specific time-limited access with the condition of paying a library fee and deposit

Research Department

The research department at our college, known as the M.Phil and Ph.D Research Department, has a rich history. It was established back in 1943, and in 1981, our college introduced the M.Phil. in Education Course. Over the years, our research department has played a significant role in advancing the field of education. Notably, Dr. B.G. Bapat made history as the first Ph.D. student from both our college and the University of Pune to successfully complete his Ph.D. under the guidance of Prof. N.V. Patankar in 1957.

In 1981, the University of Pune launched the M.Phil. Course, and since then, more than 99 students have earned their M.Phil. Degrees through this program. Additionally, starting in the academic year 2008-2009, the Yashwantrao Chavan Open University began offering its M.Phil. Course at our center. Students have enrolled in this program, and have received their M.Phil. Degrees from YCMOU.

Since the academic year 2010-11, our Research Department has been actively providing research support to teacher educators. During that year, we extended research assistance to teacher educators& research guides who are affiliated with colleges under the Savitribai Phule Pune University.

Furthermore, our esteemed faculty members have successfully completed numerous research projects, which received funding from organizations such as the UGC, BCUD, IUCTE, and ICSSR.

- Facilitate both on-campus and off-campus recruitment opportunities.


Child Right Cell

Publication of Tilak College of Education

The College has a glorious history of publication, the college was started on 20th June 1941, and the building of the college was almost ready but the college took possession on 7th August 1941, the first Annual of Tilak College of Education was published in 1942, and since 1942 till date the college is publishing Annual of Tilak College of Education every year, up to the year 2005-06. Later on, the name is given to the Annual as "Phulora"

We have conserved them in the binding form, the first book entitled "A Review of Modern Education in India" (1813 to 1941) by J.P. Naik Member of the provincial Board of Primary Education, and Member of the provincial Board of Adult Education. The book was published on 15th March 1943, and its cost was 12 Anne, later on, it was sold at Rs. 1/- Now the PDF of this book is available on the internet in the Internet Archive.


